Botanical Name	Aloe barbadensis
Part Used	Leaf
Extraction	Cold pressed
Color	Clear green
Viscosity	Light
Taste	Dull, woody, bitter
Aroma	Light
Constituents	Fatty acid esters, such as palmitic and myristic
Dermal Absorption	Absorbs quickly, leaves no oily residue
Uses	Use aloe vera oil to lighten the consistency of other massage blends. It softens the skin and reduces dryness and irritation
Storage	Store in a well-filled, airtight container at a cool temperature, protected from light.
