

HAZARDOUS/FLAMMABLE MATERIALS:

As business owners, we must abide by the rules, regulations, and laws governing our business. One important regulation concerns the shipping of hazardous materials. This regulation is covered under the U.S. government's Code of Federal Regulation 49 CFR 173.115. Per 49 CFR 173, a hazardous or flammable material, for air or ocean transportation purposes, is any product which has a flashpoint lower than 141°F (60.5°C). The flash point of a volatile liquid is the lowest temperature at which it can vaporize to form an ignitable mixture in air. Unfortunately, the U.S. Department of Transportation classifies fragrance and essential oils as Flammable or Combustible liquids (hazardous materials) and strictly enforces the regulations regarding their shipment.

These products cannot ship outside the contiguous U.S. except in limited quantities. Aroma for Life will make the final decision on how shipment will be made. Please do not ask for special shipping because we adhere strictly to Federal regulations regarding the shipment of hazardous and/or flammable materials. The oils marked with an asterisk *, (**oil name**), are considered hazardous because of the low flash point. If you order any of these oils in quantities over 30 ml. to be shipped outside the contiguous U.S., we will rebottle into 30 ml. (1 oz.) bottles and you will be charged 90 cents per bottle. ***Because this notice is posted on our Essential Oils page and Order/Ship Info page there will be no other notification. You will be charged appropriately using the same method used to place your order.***

Hazardous/flammable oils ordered in sizes 4 oz. and above to be shipped **within** the U.S. Mainland will go by ground regardless of the shipping option you choose.
